Normally, the racks are open on every side. This particular design allows easy storage of empty pallets and loaded with supplies. Normally, a lift truck or pallet truck would be used to slide underneath the bottom pallet and move the stack to its destination.

Some pallet truck units and typical lift trucks are outfitted along with revolving squeeze lift blades. After supplies are carefully secured onto the pallets, the squeeze lifts could be utilized to be able to hold the pallet and materials and raise them into a slot in the pallet racks structure.
